### *The Vine*

- AVERAGE VINE AGE 30 years
- SOIL Limestone, heavy clay.
- AVERAGE YIELD 45 hl/ha
- HARVEST Hand picked

### *Vinification & Ageing*

- FERMENTATION Traditional in stainless steel vats, temperature controlled with complete malolactic fermentation
- AGEING 8 to 10 months ageing in stainless steel vats

### *Description*

Pouilly-Fuissé is the name of a village in the Mâconnais producing highly distinctive Chardonnay wine. The vineyards producing this wine are part of a breath-taking landscape where the limestone and heavy clay soils combine to create a unique 'terroir'.

### *Wine tasting*

- TASTING NOTE In this Pouilly-Fuissé we find hints of delicious white fruits and light buttered notes. On the back-palate there is a touch of peppermint which adds to the long finish. Tasted September 2010.
- CELLARING POTENTIAL 2-3 years
- FOOD PAIRING Shellfish - charcuterie - skate - reblochon cheese.
- SERVING TEMPERATURE 10-12°
