LOUIS LATOUR 2023 VINTAGE REVIEW



VOLNAY

This red is rich and silky, offering smoky cherry and raspberry fruit. There's an underlying mineral element and well-integrated tannins, leaving a fine equilibrium. The fruit-, earth- and sandalwood-tinged finish is driven by lively acidity.

Drink now through 2038.



BEAUNE 1ER CRU Vignes Franches

Well-marked by **sweet**, **spicy oak**, this red also displays **blackberry**, **chocolate** and **bitter almond** flavors. Tips toward the **tannins**, leaving the finish lightly **astringent**. A bit jumbled today, yet there's ripeness and an elegant feel.

Best from 2028 through 2042.



BEAUNE 1ER CRU Clos du Roi

A bright, cherry- and blackberry-infused red, with a fluid feel. Notes of charred oak, sweet spices and earth add interest, but in the end, sinewy tannins rule the finish.

Best from 2028 through 2039.

PERNAND-VERGELESSES

1ER CRU Iles des Vergelesses

An expression of **cherry** and **raspberry** is wrapped in **smoky oak**. **Stony mineral** and **tomato leaf** flavors add depth as this red firms up on the dry, chalky finish. Juicy and long.

Best from 2027 through 2037.
