Description

The result of a long history, Burgundy and its wines are known worldwide. Pinot Noir is a native grape variety of the area. Bourgogne Pinot Noir is the regional appellation whose wines can come from any part of Burgundy. This wine exhibits the characteristics of the great red Burgundies.

- TASTING NOTE This Bourgogne Pinot Noir 2012 reveals an intense red color, with flecks of rubis color. The nose offers a pleasant bouquet of flavors: red fruit notes release, enriched by fine blackcurrant and blueberry aromas. Ample and powerful on tasting, this wine expresses an interesting aromatic complexity, coated in soft tannins. Blueberry and coffee aromas still linger and offer an elegant and enjoyable finish.

- FOOD PAIRING Grilled meat - mature cheeses
- SERVING TEMPERATURE 14-15°
